

# How Our Kids Stole The Show Costume Notes

## **Note from Miss Sheffield:**

Here are some notes to make this show look even better than it already does... I have already put together most of the costumes but there are a few things I need from the kids. If you have any problems at all coming up with ANY of this please let me know and I will be MORE than happy to help! Please make sure you read this entire letter as there are some specific things for specific characters! Please use whatever you have first before you buy anything new – even if it is a little off my description, that will be fine. Please have all the pieces to me (they will be returned to you after the show, I PROMISE!) by Friday January 23<sup>rd</sup> so that I can organize everything and be ready for our Saturday January 24<sup>th</sup> rehearsal! If you will be wearing your sneakers anyways on that day, you can keep those just don't forget them!!! Last year some students were missing things the day of the show so this year I want to make sure no one is stuck an hour before we open. Also, if you are interested in KEEPING any of the costumes I have built, bring in \$5 per costume.

**Note on Undergarments:** The cast should all know what their costumes look like... on the day of the show please wear neutral color undergarments that cannot be seen underneath costumes. Girls may wear neutral color leotards or camisoles if they feel more comfortable (there will be fast costume changes) but please nothing that can be seen or that will stick out. Boxers may not be the best decision for some boys costumes.

**Note on makeup:** For boys and girls: To be seen on stage natural eye make-up, lipstick and blush can be worn... none is absolutely necessary although lipstick is a big help to see those lovely smiles... BUT PLEASE – absolutely no bright unnatural colors... you are supposed to look like kids!! The Grandparents will have make-up done at school so please let me know of any allergies before hand!

**Note on hair:** Girls and boys can wear their hair however they would like unless there is a note in your costume section! If that note on hair cannot be done at home we will do it at school.

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**(If there is no specific note for a specific character, I've taken care of everything)**

- **EVERYONE (except Victoria Skonieczny, Kayleigh Roman, Symantha Fazzino, Matthew Michaud, Joei Maenza, and Matthew Roberts) :**
  - Will need a PLAIN BLACK short sleeve T-Shirt, PLAIN BLUE JEANS, and sneakers.
  
- **Grandma:**
  - Some sort of heeled shoes (tan or white would be ideal but whatever you have is fine – don't buy anything new!)
  - Hair will be under a wig (I have the wig)
  
- **Grandpa:**
  - Khaki Pants (preferably without pockets but use what you have)
  - Dress shoes (use whatever you have)
  
- **Showstealer Lucy:**
  - White tights
  - White shoes
  - Hair in Pigtails
  
- **Showstealer Becky:**
  - skin color tights
  - white shoes
  - hair in half pony tail
  
- **Showstealer Carly:**
  - white tights
  - white shoes
  - hair in pigtails
  
- **Showstealer Tyler:**
  - Khaki pants
  - Dress shoes (that are easy to move in) or NICE sneakers
  
- **Mary (Secret Garden):**
  - Skin color tights
  - White shoes

- **John (Peter Pan) :**
  - Slippers
  
- **Anne (Anne of Green Gables):**
  - Skin color tights
  - White shoes
  - Hair half up half down
  
- **Ngana (South Pacific):**
  - Beachy flip flops or barefoot (your choice)
  - Hair half up half down
  
- **Jerome (South Pacific):**
  - Beachy Flip Flops or barefoot (your choice)
  
- **Michael (Peter Pan):**
  - Teddy Bear
  
- **Sound of Music Girls**
  - White socks folded to ankle
  - Plain white shoes (can be dress shoes or sneakers as long as they are plain)
  - Braided pigtails
  
- **Sound of Music Boys**
  - White socks folded to ankle
  - Plain white shoes
  - Hair with a side part if possible
  
- **Annie Orphans:**
  - White socks (any height)
